ORDINANCE NO. 022-2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASLET, TEXAS APPROVING THE ANNUAL SERVICE PLAN UPDATE TO THE SERVICE AND ASSESSMENT PLAN, INCLUDING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL, FOR HASLET PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3 IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 372, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AS AMENDED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2016, after notice and a public hearing in the manner required by law, the City Council (the "*City Council*") of the City of Haslet, Texas (the "*City*") passed and approved Resolution No. 006-2016 authorizing the creation of Haslet Public Improvement District No. 3 (the "*PID No. 3*") for the NorthGlen project; and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2016, after notice and a public hearing in the manner required by law, the City Council passed Ordinance No.023-2016 approving the "City of Haslet Public Improvement District No. 3 Service and Assessment Plan," including the Assessment Roll attached to the Service and Assessment Plan as Appendix C (the "*Assessment Roll*"), dated September 19, 2016 (the "*Service and Assessment Plan*") and levied the Assessments on property within PID No. 3 in accordance with the Assessment Roll for the purposes of financing the public improvements (the "*Authorized Improvements*") undertaken for the benefit of such property; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 372, Texas Local Government Code (as amended, the "*PID Act*") requires the Service and Assessment Plan to be reviewed and updated annually for the purposes of determining the annual budget for the Authorized Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the "City of Haslet Public Improvement District No. 3 (NorthGlen) 2017 Annual Service Plan Update" (the "*Annual Service Plan Update*") which includes the updated Assessment Roll and now desires to proceed with the adoption of this Ordinance which approves and adopts the Annual Service Plan Update and updated Assessment Roll for PID No. 3 as required by the PID Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASLET, TEXAS:

Section 1. Terms. Terms not otherwise defined herein are defined in the Service and Assessment Plan.

Section 2. Findings. That the recitals and findings in the Recitals of this Ordinance are hereby found and determined to be true and correct and constitute the legislative findings and determinations of the City Council.

Section 3. Assessment Plan. The Annual Service Plan Update, including the updated Assessment Roll contained therein, in the form attached as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved and the same is are incorporated as part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in the body of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or the application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the governing body of the City in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof, or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, or invalidity of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable for that purpose.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with applicable law.

INTRODUCTION

The City of Haslet Public Improvement District No. 3 (NorthGlen) ("PID No. 3") was created pursuant to the PID Act and a resolution of the City Council on June 6, 2016 to finance certain public improvement projects for the benefit of the property in PID No. 3. On September 19, 2016, the City Council adopted and approved a service and assessment plan (the "Service and Assessment Plan") for PID No. 3, including an Assessment Roll, and levied Assessments on property within PID No. 3 to finance certain public improvements (the "Authorized Improvements") for the benefit of such property. The Assessment Roll identifies the assessments (the "Assessments") one each Lot within PID No. 3, based on the method of assessment identified in the Service and Assessment Plan. Additionally, the City and the Developer entered into that certain PID Reimbursement Agreement - NorthGlen between the City and the Developer dated September 19, 2016 (the "PID Reimbursement Agreement") to provide for the prepayment or reimbursement of costs of the Authorized Improvements. Under the terms of the PID Reimbursement Agreement, the Developer is entitled to receive payments in the principal amount of \$10,366,000, plus simple interest on the unpaid principal balance at the rate of 6.00% per year for the first five years after the Trigger Date and 5.00% per annum thereafter.

The "Service and Assessment Plan" identifies the Authorized Improvements to be constructed, the costs of the Authorized Improvements, the indebtedness to be incurred for the Authorized Improvements, and the manner of assessing the property in PID No. 3 for the costs of the Authorized Improvements. Pursuant to Chapter 372, Texas Local Government Code as amended, the (the "Act"), the Service and Assessment Plan must be reviewed and updated annually. This document is the annual update of the Service and Assessment Plan for 2017 (the "Annual Service Plan Update"). This Annual Service Plan Update also updates the Assessment Roll for 2017. Capitalized terms used in this Annual Service Plan Update shall have the meanings set forth in the Service and Assessment Plan or the PID Reimbursement Agreement, as applicable.

BUDGET FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PID AUTHORIZED IMPROVEMENTS

The Authorized Improvements consist of water, sanitary sewer, drainage system, and street infrastructure. Per the Developer, the estimated cost of the Authorized Improvements remains unchanged at \$12,026,000, as shown in the table below.

Note: The budget for the Authorized Improvements will be adjusted in future Annual Service Plan Updates as the Authorized Improvements are constructed and the Actual Costs of the Authorized Improvements can be determined.

DEBT SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATION EXPENSES

Debt Service

- **Interest Rate** - Pursuant to the PID Reimbursement Agreement, the Annual Installment shall include interest on the unpaid principal amount of the Assessment at a rate of 6.00% per annum for the first five years after the Trigger Date and 5.00% per annum thereafter, simple interest.
- **Prepayment** - The Assessment imposed on any Parcel may be paid in full at any time. To date, no prepayments have occurred.
- **Annual Installments** - If not paid in full, the Assessment shall be payable in thirty annual installments of principal and interest beginning on the Trigger Date.

Administration Expenses

The cost of administering the PID and collecting the Annual Installments shall be paid for equally by each parcel based on the total amount of Administrative Expenses. The Administrative Expenses shall be collected as part of and in the same manner as Annual Installments in the amounts shown on Appendix A - Assessment Roll Update. The estimated Total Administrative Expenses to be incurred annually is \$12,000.

FIVE YEAR BUDGET FORECAST

The Act requires the annual indebtedness and projected costs for the Authorized Improvements to be reviewed and updated in the Annual Service Plan Update, and the projection shall cover a period of not less than five years.

(a) Year 1 will commence for each lot as follows: (1) with respect to a well easement utility lot, the date such well easement utility lot has been redeveloped into a single family lot as evidenced by the City's issuance of a building permit for a residential home on such lot, and (2) with respect to all other unimproved parcels, the date the final plat has been recorded in the real property records of Tarrant County, a habitable structure has been constructed thereon and a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the City.

(b) Budget assumes no prepayments. In the event of a prepayment, the figures shown will be reduced.

(c) Preliminary estimate. Annual Administrative Costs will be determined each year during the Annual Service Plan Update.
