GENERAL ELECTION TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5TH

On Election Day, Tuesday, November 5th, there are ten proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution on the ballot.

A complete summary of the amendments by the Texas Secretary of State is available at WWW.VOTETEXAS.GOV. Early voting is Monday October 21st to Friday November 1st. This election will be Tarrant County's first election using the "Voting Center" format. Voters no longer have a voting location assigned by precinct number. On Election Day, you can vote at any open polling location in Tarrant County, just as you can during Early Voting. 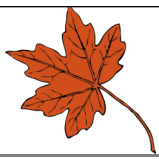


ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES CONTACT UPDATE

They have a high success rate with more than 50% of impounded animals returned to their owners and with 95% of unclaimed domestic animals being adopted or transferred to a rescue. HASLET WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASED

Haslet City Council enacted a 15% increase in Water and Sewer Rates effective October 1st with the approval of Ordinance 033-2019. This rate increase includes funding a water meter replacement program that will upgrade the system to use “smart” meters. Some of the service enhancements of the smart meters include meter reading efficiency, faster leak detection, improved billing and reporting functions, and an app for customers to access their usage information.
