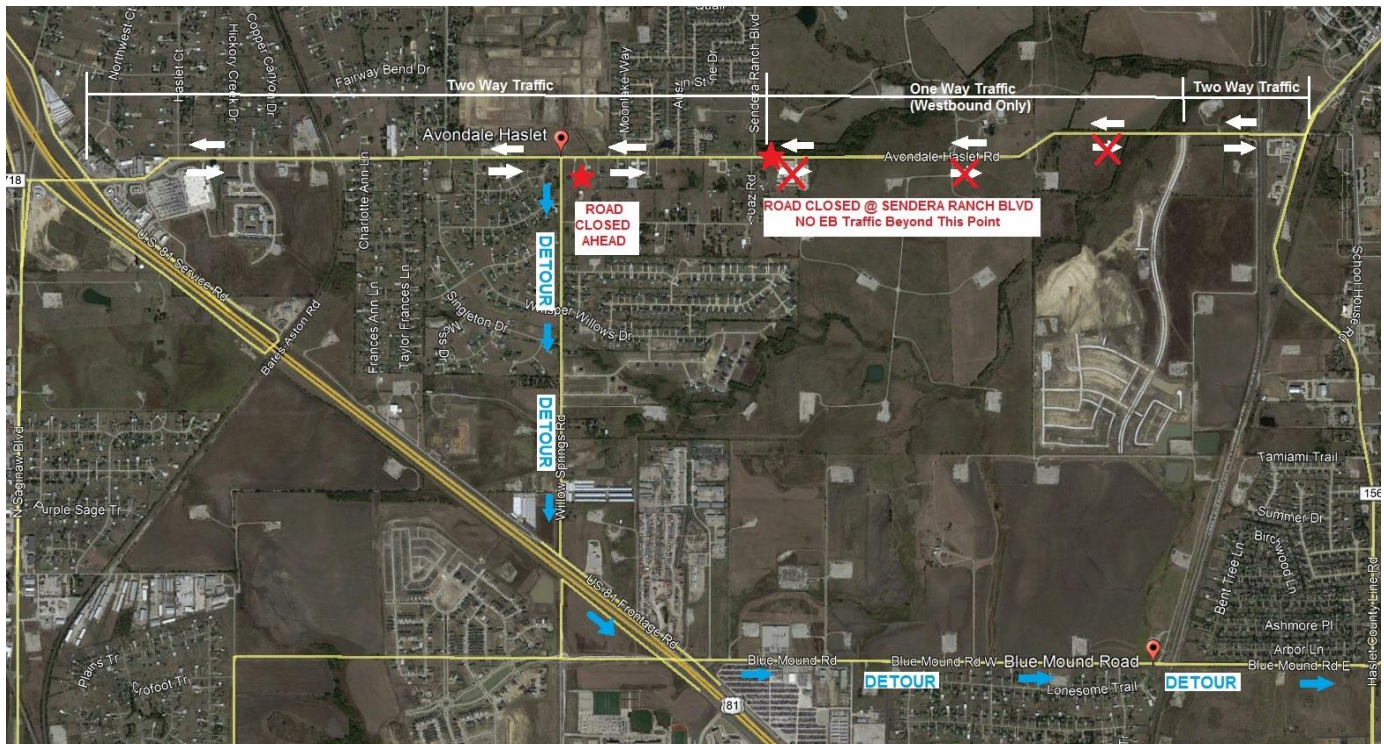
Avondale Haslet Road Construction Notification

July 20, 2020

Working through a mutual partnership agreement, Tarrant County, Precinct 3, under the direction of the City of Fort Worth will provide the construction services to rehabilitate and resurface Avondale Haslet Road from east of Sendera Ranch Boulevard to the Fort Worth City limits near the s-curve. While the roadway is partially shut down for the Fort Worth project, we will also make pavement repairs to Avondale Haslet Road from the s-curve to FM 156 for the City of Haslet. This project is a cooperative effort to repair and improve the current pavement condition of Avondale Haslet Road. This maintenance project will rehabilitate the roadway in its present configuration with no additional width or turn lanes added.

Construction is scheduled to begin **Monday, August 3rd**. Roadway construction work hours will be between 8:15 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and the project should be completed by Friday, August 28th.

Monday, August 3 – Friday, August 28: During this period, we will recycle, stabilize the existing road base materials and place the new asphalt surface. Please be aware that **AVONDALE HASLET ROAD WILL BE CLOSED AT SENDERA RANCH BOULEVARD TO ALL EASTBOUND TRAFFIC, Monday – Friday from 8:15 am to 4 pm.** All traffic exiting the neighborhoods and businesses between Willow Springs Road and Sendera Ranch Blvd as well as all other through traffic on Avondale Haslet **MUST DETOUR TO WILLOW SPRINGS ROAD AND BLUE MOUND ROAD** to continue east to access FM 156. (Current construction on Blue Mound Road between US 287 and FM 156 will be complete before construction begins on Avondale Haslet Road). No one will be allowed to turn or continue east toward FM 156 past Sendera Ranch Boulevard. This partial closure is being done to prevent excessive delays which would occur if we attempted to flag the heavy volume of traffic through the construction area on one traffic lane while we construct the adjacent lane. All roadways will be re-opened and traffic restored to normal operations after 4 pm. Access for emergency services will be available at all times.



Monday, August 10 – Friday, August 28: During this period, in conjunction with the rehabilitation project on Avondale Haslet Road between Sendera Ranch Blvd and the s-curve, repairs will be made to Avondale Haslet Road between the newly constructed John Day Road and FM 156. During this phase, traffic on Avondale Haslet Road will be reduced to one lane in the areas being repaired. Flaggers will direct traffic one direction at a time through the construction area. **EXPECT 10 – 15 MIN DELAYS**. All roadways will be re-opened after 4 pm. Access for emergency services will be available at all times.

Typically, we find the first week to be the most challenging until the traffic becomes accustomed to the traffic control measures and/or adjust itself to the alternative routes. Please know that we will be aggressively pursuing completion of this project while attempting to minimize the public's inconvenience as much as possible. During certain times, our operations may limit your access. We will do our best to accommodate you as quickly as possible. **Please use alternative routes (Willow Springs Road and Blue Mound Road) when possible and plan on 10 to 15 minute delays if you must travel through the construction area or detour.**

The schedule provided is weather and material delivery pending.

Your safety and the safety of our crews are of the utmost importance. Please be patient, drive slowly through the construction zone and be keenly aware of the large equipment and personnel working to make improvements for you. Plan extra time for delays if you must travel through the construction area or use alternative routes. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to make these improvements.
