GENERAL ELECTION FOR COUNCIL MEMBER PLACES 1, 3 & 5 AND SPECIAL MEASURE ELECTION CALLED REGARDING SALES & USE TAX FOR SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2016

At the February 1, 2016, Regular City Council Meeting, City Council called the General Election to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2016, for the selection of Council Member Places 1, 3 & 5. The term of office will be May 2016 to May 2018. The deadline to file to run for any of these offices is close of business on Friday, February 19, 2016. Application packets are available at City Hall. At the same meeting, Council also approved calling a Special Measure Election for the same date to submit to the voters of Haslet the combined ballot proposition as follows:

PROPOSITION

The reduction of the current one half of one percent (0.5%) sales and use tax allocated to the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC - Type A) by one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) and the adoption of a local sales and use tax at a rate of one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

Approval of the proposition would allocate funding from sales and use tax that is now collected for the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC—Type A) to be halved between the HEDC—Type A (0.25%) and city street maintenance and road repairs (0.25%). In the event this proposition is not approved, the 0.5% sales and use tax currently allocated to the Haslet Economic Development Corporation (HEDC—Type A) will remain unchanged. 2ND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PUBLIC INPUT MEETING HELD & 3RD MEETING SCHEDULED FOR WEDNESDAY, MARCH 2, 2016

On Feb. 3, 2016, the second Comprehensive Plan Public Input Meeting was held. Members of the professional planning firm, LandDesign, facilitated the meeting and presented concepts they developed based on analysis of input received to date from staff, stakeholders, the Comp Plan Advisory Subcommittee and citizens. There was a question and answer session and the opportunity for one-on-one interaction between the comprehensive plan team and those in attendance. This input will be considered in development of the final proposed comprehensive plan. Another Public Input Meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 2, 2016, in the Haslet Community Center at 7 p.m. Your input is crucial to the success of this plan, so please attend this meeting. 
