City of Haslet Achieves Traditional Finances Transparency Star Award

Kransparency S The City of Haslet has been awarded the Traditional Finances Star in the Texas Comptroller Transparency Stars Program. To achieve this award, the City met the program guidelines for providing financial information via the City's website that is transparent to the public, that provides clear information regarding city spending, and is in a format that is easy to use that can be searched. The main criteria for the award includes having the city's budget, audit, and check register available online to the public. The information is to be kept up to date. Some of the other recommended criteria to be included on the website is contact information for city council members and key staff; municipal codes; past city council meeting agendas and minutes; detailed summary information about current bonded debt and repayment: and a link to the Comptroller's governmental transparency website. This is the second year that the City has applied for and received a financial transparency award. The city will receive an award certificate and will be listed on the Comptroller's website at www.texastransparency.org with a link to Haslet's own website.
