## HASLET TRAIL SYSTEM EXPANDED TO OVER 3 MILES

On October 26th a ribbon cutting ceremony was held to officially open the Schoolhouse Road and FM 156 Shared Use Path. This paved trail is a length of 1.40 miles and increases the total of Haslet available paved trails to over 3 miles. This project was funded by the 2015 Transportation Alternatives Program Federal Grant (awarded to the City in April 2015), the City of Haslet and the Haslet Community & Economic Development Corporation Type B. The project construction was coordinated by the Texas Department of Transportation. This trail complements the amenities available to Haslet residents via the city's park system and enhances quality of life. Walking has many health benefits including strengthening the heart, lowering blood sugar, boosting immune function, improving mood, and extending length of life.
