### **HASLET WATER SYSTEM RESTORATION IS UNDERWAY**

The City of Haslet is currently filling city water storage tanks and pumping water out into the water system from our provider's (Fort Worth's) supply. As water is being restored system-wide to individual homes, Haslet Public Works is seeing water use pick up dramatically. This high use is affecting the efforts to get the City's water system refilled and back to appropriate pressure. Low pressure delays the City's ability to lift the Boil Water Notice.

If water service is restored at your residence, please continue to conserve until this water situation is fully resolved! Help us, help you! Turn off all unneeded plumbing fixtures. Leave only a fixture dripping to help prevent pipes from freezing.

What this means to you? Nearly every property in Haslet should be seeing at least a trickle of water later this evening and tonight. Pressure will vary based upon where you live along the system. As your water is returning, there will be a large amount of air that needs to be released from the water system. Please leave your faucets open until the air has stopped and only water is flowing. Once the water is flowing please shut off all fixtures then set a fixture to dripping to prevent pipes from freezing.

Again please, please conserve, as too much water demand will only slow down efforts to bring the system back online.

The Boil Water Notice remains in effect. We expect to be able to lift that soon but please continue to boil water being used for consumption until the Boil Water Notice is rescinded.
